

IMPAIRMENT RATING

Spectrum Medical's Impairment Ratings usually takes between 30-45 minutes to complete and the report will be completed and sent to the treating physician to be signed and documented.

A Impairment Rating is a number expressed as a percentage that is intended to represent the degree of an individual's impairment, which is a deviation away from one's normal health status and functionality. Impairment is distinct from disability. An individual's impairment rating is based on the restrictive impact of impairment, whereas disability is a broader term that describes the consequences one's impairment.

An Impairment Ratings involves assessments using the following:

- Medical History and Various Questionnaires
- Computerized Strength Testing
- Range of Motion Measurements Dexterity Testing
- The customization of testing is determined by the patient's specific injury.
